- Assessment and planning of dog grooming work (written)
- Promoting and maintaining the health and wellbeing of animals (written)
- Health checking a dog by a dog groomer (CDA)



Optional units (2 credits)

(examined by centre derived assessments - CDA)

TRAINING

Training is completed at a registered NPTC training centre or Pet Care Trust satellite centre along side an appointed and trained mentor.

ASSESSMENT

Assessed on evidence resulting from:

- Practical assessment
- Written short answer examination taken in either June or November

CERTIFICATION

Once all the units have been successfully completed you will receive a certificate from City & Guilds/NPTC.
